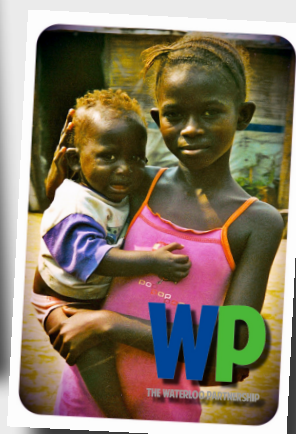

Gift Aid guidance

Charities can reclaim tax paid on donations made by individual taxpayers under the Gift Aid scheme. The donor must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax for a tax year (06 April to 05 April) at least equal to the tax repayment claimed on their donations by all the Charities and Community Amateur Sports Clubs (CASCs) to whom the donor donates in that tax year. Other taxes such as VAT and Council Tax do not qualify. If you pay income tax at the higher rate and want to receive additional tax relief, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your self assessment tax return, or ask HMRC to adjust your tax code.
